

## A PARISH PICNIC THANK YOU from Fr. Nau:

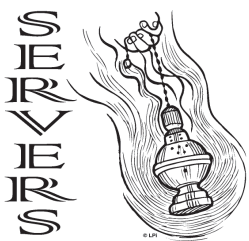

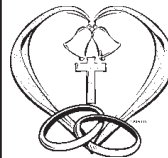

### CATHOLIC SCHOOL SUBSIDY:

Dear Parishioners, the assessments for Triumph of the Cross to the Catholic Schools for the 2010 - 2011 school year is as follows:

Catholic Central High School	\$74,217.00
BJKM – Elementary	\$103,741.00
BJKM – Junior High	\$34,580.00

That is a total amount of **\$212,538.00** is used from our parish collections to support Catholic Education. Each month we pay \$17,711.50 to the schools before paying our own utility expenses, payroll, insurance payments, diocesan monthly assessment and maintenance needs.

**D/PSC UPDATE:** We have been blessed to receive \$95,113.00 in pledges and payments thus far from 355 families who have responded in some form. Please note that over 1000 households still claim to be part of the parish but have not even responded to assure us of their prayers. Also, the D/PSC does not support the building of the new Cathedral. Remember, after achieving payment of the \$77,100.00 target all monies is returned to the parish for our operations. Talk with your fellow parishioners and remind them that the material (financial) support of the church is one of the Precepts of the Church.

### LIFT HIGH THE CROSS CAMPAIGN UPDATE:

These are the funds being contributed and set aside for the building of the New Cathedral. I am sure that you have read the financial report in the Steubenville Register concerning this fund. As Triumph of the Cross Parish, \$1,226,406.19 was pledged. As of July 1, 2010 \$751,895.38 has been paid. This leaves \$474,510.00 of unpaid pledges. We appreciate those who continue to fulfill their pledges.
