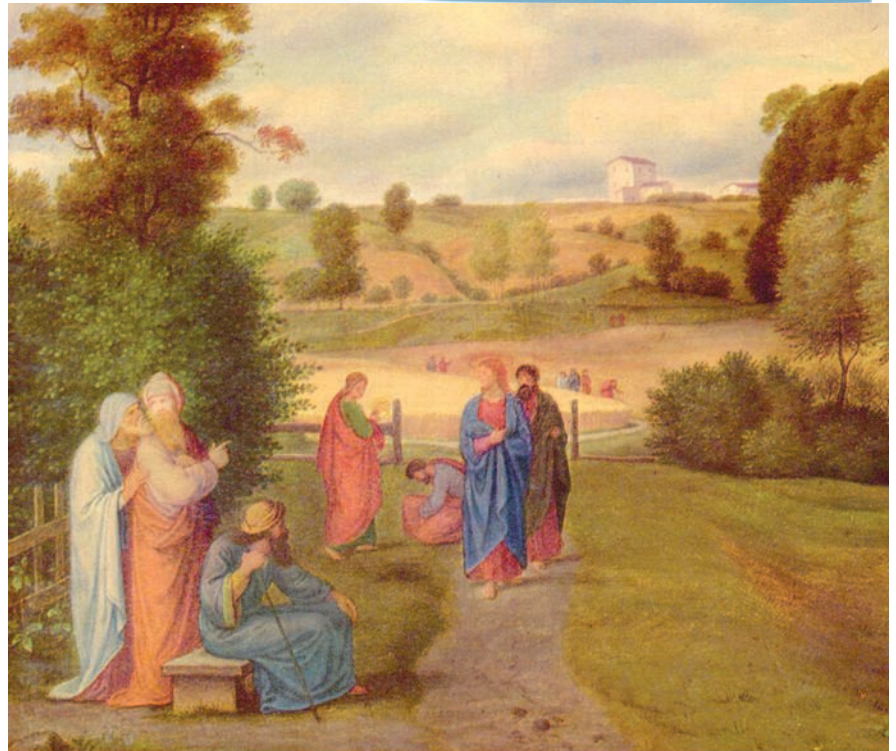

# TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS – PARISH COMMUNITY NEWS

**REMEMBER:** The daily **7:00 a.m. Mass** will be prayed at **Holy Rosary Church**, Monday through Friday, July 9<sup>th</sup> through July 27<sup>th</sup>. The doors will open about 6:30 A.M. each day. At Holy Name Cathedral the 4:00 p.m. and 10:30 a.m. **weekend Masses of July 14/15 and July 21/22 will be cancelled.** Our parish Masses will be at Holy Rosary Church. We will follow the usual weekend schedule of Saturday 4:00 p.m. and Sunday of 8:30 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 11:30 a.m., and 5:30 p.m.



**PARISH OFFICE REPAIRS:** During the construction process there will be no entrance into the Offices. The staff will be available to answer the phone Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., our regular hours of operation.

**REPAIR UPDATES.** The following information is based upon the status of things as of Tuesday, July 10, 2012.

**1. CATHEDRAL ELECTRICAL FIRE:** It was birds' nests that had been built into the electrical conduit on the exterior wall of the Cathedral that caused the fire. This caught fire on Saturday evening July 7, prior to our 4:00 p.m. Mass. Thankfully our parishioners saw it as they were coming to Mass and called for the City of Steubenville Fire Department. They contacted AEP who immediately came and disconnected the electrical service. The Fire Department dealt with the fire issue and monitored the situation while we had Mass by candlelight – special for Mike and Carolyn Nelson's 30<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary celebration.

TS Electric came reviewed the needed repairs and because of the size of wiring was unable to repair the service until Monday. We were able to have the appropriate inspections and AEP is supposed to be back today to turn on the service.

During this time we were welcomed guests at St. Peter's church. Thank you Fr. Huffman and Fr. Shell.

**2. CATHEDRAL ORGAN:** Since they will be using scaffolding and needed access to the ceiling in the area of where the pipes for the organ are located and to avoid any damage to this magnificent organ, we have the Peebles-Herzog, Inc. removing some of the pipes and protecting the others during this time. The Diocese is paying for this as part of their project. The parish is paying to have in the 16' Soubasse the stopper / tuning mechanisms repacked. This is a very cost effective opportunity for us.

### **3. CATHEDRAL CEILING REPAIR AND PAINTING:**

At this point, they are to begin moving the scaffolding into the Cathedral on Wednesday morning at about 7:30 a.m. and proceed to perform the work.

**4. CATHEDRAL FRONT STEPS:** On Wednesday morning the architect, Mr. Mark Viola, is to meet with the concrete company who was the successful bidder for the project and review the project before the work actually begins. It is my understanding that all city permits have been obtained at this time.

**5. PARISH OFFICES:** On Monday, July 9<sup>th</sup> Mr. Reed and his crew did the demolition work on the entrance to the parish office. The staff and I have been slipping in through the basement door to the offices. We now have a big hole in front of the office doors and they have begun the re-construction work. All seems to be progressing as originally planned. I am sure that every one will enjoy having an entrance with no steps and also a sidewalk that leads from the front to the adoration chapel.

**THANK YOU:** We are able to accomplish the ceiling repairs and front step replacement at the Cathedral through the assistance of the Diocese of Steubenville. We are able to accomplish the minor repair to the organ and the Parish Office wall replacement because of the generosity of parishioners to the Building Repair Fund. Thank you for your treasures and continue to pray that we use all of time, talents, and treasures wisely for the glory of God.

**WELCOME PRESTON HUCK TO TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS PARISH!** Preston will be working in our parish community during the next six months. This is a description of his journey in his own words:

"I was born February 4, 1976 in Marietta, Ohio to Neil and Joyce Huck. I have 2 sisters, Charity & Josie, and 1 brother, Daron. I was a member of St. Mary's Parish and attended St. Mary's school through the 8th grade. I graduated from Warren High School in 1994 and then continued studies at Washington State Community College. In 1996 I transferred to Ohio University in Athens, Ohio and graduated in 2000 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mechanical Engineering. From 2000 to 2007 I worked as an engineer in the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program at various sites in New York, Ohio and Pennsylvania. While working in Pittsburgh, I decided to enter the seminary in order to discern a vocation to the priesthood. I spent 2 years at St. Paul Seminary in Pittsburgh while studying Philosophy at Duquesne University. I was assigned to pursue theology studies at the Pontifical North American College in Rome, Italy beginning July 2009 and graduated from the Pontifical Gregorian University with a Bachelor's Degree in Theology in June 2012. For the past 5 years I have been studying as a seminarian for the Diocese of Pittsburgh. In order to help finalize the discernment of which diocese I am called to serve, the Bishop of Pittsburgh has offered me the opportunity to spend a year in parish ministry, 6 months in the Diocese of Steubenville and then 6 months in the Diocese of Pittsburgh, in order to help finalize the discernment process before moving on to ordination. I look forward to spending the next 6 months with the people of Steubenville and gaining experience in parish ministry. My favorite hobbies are motorcycle riding, golf and watching Ohio State Buckeye football."
